## **ABOUT METROBEAT TV:**

**"Student Voices: Teen Suicide"** is a MetroBeat TV program.

MetroBeat TV is a collaborative pilot project between Comcast and 25 greater Denver Metropolitan Area communities. It was designed to explore new potential uses of cable television technologies that would meet both the unique needs of local communities beyond the current television models, and increase the value of community programming to citizens at a regional level.

MetroBeat TV is a series of five dynamic 30-minute programs that highlight local and regional people, places and happenings, based on what viewers say they want to see – topics and people featured on MetroBeat TV programs come largely from ideas that viewers submit on the project's [www.metrobeat.tv](http://www.metrobeat.tv) Web site.

The MetroBeat TV lineup airs simultaneously on Comcast Channel 8 in the Metro Denver region every Thursday from 7:30-10 p.m. and Sunday from 11:30 a.m.-2 p.m. New shows debut each month. (Days and times for MetroBeat TV programs may vary in some communities – check local listings.)

Viewers can also watch the programs anytime with Comcast's On Demand service for digital subscribers. Encore episodes of previously aired MetroBeat programs also are shown on CET Channel 5.
